



Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible to attend Summer Camp?

Summer Camp is open to youth from any community, who are in kindergarten up to seventh grade during the 2025-2026 school year.

When does Summer Camp registration open?

Registration will take place on the MyClubHub Parent Portal and opens on the following dates:

Current Fun Club Members: Monday, February 2nd @ 12:00 p.m.

All Active Club Members & Returning Camp Families: Wednesday, February 11th @ 12:00 p.m.

Public Registration: Monday, February 23rd @ 12:00 p.m.

The Club offers Priority Registration for current Fun Club members, and their siblings, who are enrolled as of 2/2/2026. On 2/11/2026, families who have current, active youth members (as of 1/23/2026) in the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Billerica, including drop-in & aquatics families, as well as any families who participated in Summer Camp 2025 are able to register during this window. Any remaining spots will open for public registration after these priority windows close. All registration is on a first come, first serve basis.

How do I register for Summer Camp?

All registration will take place on the MyClubHub Parent Portal. Detailed instructions can be found at www.billericabgc.com/summer-camp-2026.

What are the sessions for camp this summer?

Summer camp consists of 3 sessions. Families can enroll in as many sessions as they would like. There is no weekly enrollment option. Families must enroll their child in the entire session. Below are our session dates:

Session 1: June 29th – July 2nd (Camp closed Friday, July 3rd)

Session 2: July 6th - July 24th

Session 3: July 27th - August 14th

Our session model provides strong consistency, support and safety for our summer campers and full camp program and supports our goal of providing a high quality, enriching experience for all our camp members.

How is Summer Camp staffed?

Our Summer Camp is licensed by the Billerica Board of Health and follows Massachusetts Department of Public Health regulations. Campers are assigned to groups with age-appropriate peers. We maintain a staff to child ratio of 1:5 for youth ages 6 and under and 1:10 for youth ages 7-13. Staff are background checked annually and trained in a variety of topics including positive behavior management, active supervision, and First Aid, AED and CPR.

What will my kids do at Summer Camp?

Summer Camp runs Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Camp incorporates all elements necessary for a quality program, balancing physical activity, social recreation, emotional development, educational opportunities, field trips, special events and more! Through a variety of programs and activities, we encourage youth to try new things, make new friends, and are always on the look-out for ways to bring new experiences to our youth.

Each week of camp is theme-based, and we encourage all staff and campers to dress up and get involved! A full list of weekly themes, dress-up days, and special events will be available prior to camp for families to plan accordingly.

Extended Hours: For those who need additional care, the Club provides extended hours at the end of the camp day. For an additional fee, campers can participate from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Will there be field trips this summer?

Yes! Campers will be going on field trips Weeks 2-7 of Summer Camp. Past field trips have included Water Country, In the Game, Houghton Pond, Connors Farm, Fun World, local beaches and swimming areas, local zoos and more.

All campers and group staff attend scheduled field trips and there is no option to stay at the Club on field trip days. Any camper who does not plan to attend the field trip must stay home from camp on that day.

A detailed list of field trips will be shared after registration with families once all bookings have been finalized.

Will there be swimming this summer?

Yes! Our licensed indoor pool is a favorite spot for many campers throughout the summer and every group swims at least 3 times per week. The pool is staffed by Red Cross (or equivalent) certified lifeguards, and the ratio of lifeguards to youth is 1:25. All children who plan to enter the pool will be swim tested and provided with a USCG life jacket if they cannot swim. What are the fees?

- A non-refundable \$50 registration fee is required for all Summer Camp participants.
- A non-refundable deposit per child of \$75 for Session 1, and \$125 for Session 2 & 3 is due by April 17th, 2026. This deposit is put towards your full camp tuition.
- Session tuition:

Session 1: June 29th – July 2nd - \$220
Session 2: July 6th - July 24th - \$825
Session 3: July 27th - August 14th - \$825
- Extended Day (optional) – Extended day operates from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Session 1 Extended Day costs \$48. Sessions 2 & 3s Extended Day costs \$180 per session. Limited spots are available.

Are there discounts available?

Boys & Girls Club of Greater Billerica offers the following discount for Summer Camp:

- Sibling Discount: A 10% discount will be applied to the second and third child, if applicable.

Please note that the Club no longer provides an ACH automatic payment discount due to changes to our fee structure.

What if I have a Voucher?

Full-time vouchers will be accepted during the summer. Families will register through the MyClubHub system and pay the registration fee to secure your child's spot. After registering, email Kelly at childcarebilling@billericabgc.com to discuss your family's voucher parent fee and the registration fee will be applied to your parent fees once confirmed. We only accept 30 vouchers throughout the summer.

Is Financial Assistance available?

Financial assistance is available for those who qualify and is limited. All families interested in financial aid must register on our MyClubHub Parent Portal and pay the registration fee to secure your child's spot. Financial aid applications are available at www.billericabgc.com/summer-camp-2026, and must be completed with the necessary documents included and emailed to childcarebilling@billericabgc.com by March 10th, 2026. Award letters will be sent no later than April 15th, 2026.

Any schedule changes must be emailed to childcarebilling@billericabgc.com by June 1, 2026. If you notify our office via email prior to June 1, 2026 you can apply your deposits to another session of camp. No refunds will be provided.
